Loading PowerNet TwinClient

Instructions for loading PowerNet TwinClient on the Apex III

- On the PC containing TwinClient Manager
 - 1. Click 'Start'
 - a. Highlight 'Programs'
 - b. Highlight 'PowerNet'
 - 2. Click on 'TwinClient Manager'

Note:

If the software is not loaded on the PC, go to http://www.compsee.com/ApexIII/apexiiidownloads.htm, download Twin Client Manager and install on the PC.)

• Configuring General Terminal Settings within TwinClient Manager

Easiest route: Select 'File', then 'Wizard'.
The Wizard will walk you through steps 1-12 below.

Click on the Following -

- 1. Settings
- 2. Emulation
- 3. The Emulation type desired and then click 'OK'
- 4. Settings
- 5. Servers
- 6. Add
 - Enter the Server Name, IP address and terminal emulation type, then click 'OK'.
- 7. Settings
- 8. Options
 - Choose 'Terminal type' and 'Radio type' desired and then click 'OK'
- 9. File
- 10. Save As
 - Enter the desired file name (e.g. Apex VT.cf)
- 11. Save

Loading Twin Client onto the Apex III

- 1. Click 'Terminal'
- 2. Click 'Send Program file to terminal'
- 3. Click 'Yes' to load configuration files.
- 4. Place Apex III in cradle, and at the 'C' prompt, type 'ld' and depress enter.
 - The LD.bat utility will run
 - Click 'OK' on the PC to begin the download transfer

Before beginning, make sure no other applications are running that may be accessing your PC's serial port.

- 5. When download is complete, shut the Apex III down by depressing the 'FN' and the red power button.
- 6. The Apex III will reboot when you power back up by depressing the red power button.

• Configuring/Editing network related settings on the Apex III

Local IP address

- 1. On the Apex III keypad, depress 'SHIFT', 'C' at the TwinClient copyright screen.
- 2. At the Edit Functions Menu, select the 'Edit IP' option.
- 3. Depress 'ENTER'
- 4. Key in a valid IP address, subnet mask, and, if necessary, the router information. Depress 'ENTER' after each entry.
- 5. Depress 'F3' to Save configuration.

Host Address

- 1. On the Apex III keypad, depress 'SHIFT', 'C' at the TwinClient screen.
- 2. At the Edit Functions Menu, arrow down to the 'Edit Host List' option.
- 3. Depress 'ENTER'
- 4. Key in the IP address of the Host to which terminal will be connected.
- 5. Enter the ethernet port number (typically port 23)
- 6. Depress 'F3' to Save configuration.

RF Net ID/ESS ID

- 1. On the Apex III keypad, depress 'SHIFT', 'C' at the TwinClient screen.
- 2. At the Edit Functions Menu, arrow down to the 'Edit Radio' option.
- 3. Depress 'ENTER'
- 4. Key in the ID that will be used for RF network ID.
- 5. Depress 'F3' to Save configuration.
