- Immediate compliance with the retailer's EDI mandates.

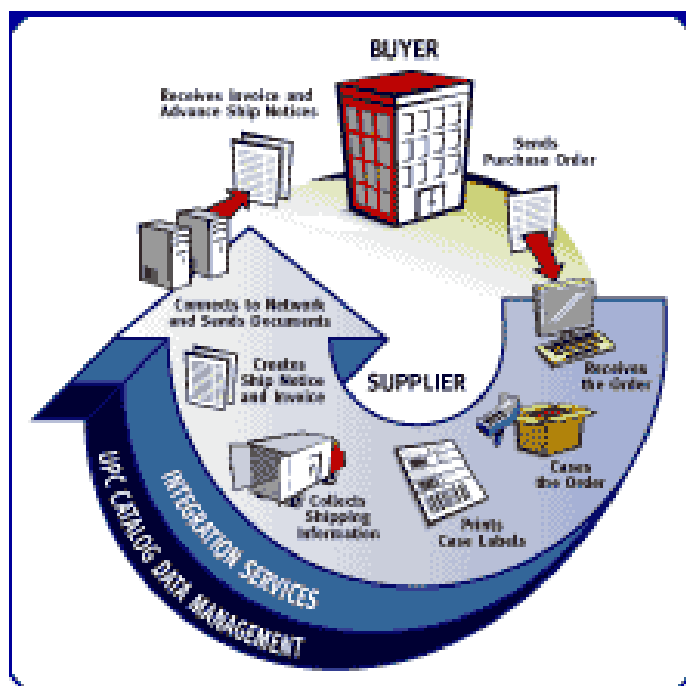
